Meet former HUD Secretary Henry Cisneros at the SALSA THE VOTE RALLY hosted by the Hispanic Initiative for the Democrats of Lebanon County and City.

The first Latino to serve as mayor of a major U.S. city (San Antonio, 1981-89), Henry Cisneros went on to serve as Secretary of Housing and Urban Development (1993-97) under President William Clinton. At HUD, Cisneros was responsible for administering fair housing activities and economic development programs.

Cisneros graduated from Texas A&M and holds a master's in public administration from the John F. Kennedy School of Government at Harvard and a doctorate in public administration from George Washington University.

After a few years working in public service in San Antonio, Cisneros was appointed a White House Fellow in 1971 and assigned as assistant to Elliott Richardson who was Secretary of Health, Education, and Welfare.

Cisneros co-founded CityView in 2000 and currently serves as the firm's chairman. CityView is an investment management and development firm which, according to their website, "targets complex multifamily housing opportunities in densely populated urban markets primarily in the Western United States. The firm prides itself on its ability to be a part of revitalizing neighborhoods within metropolitan areas while at the same time striving to generate meaningful returns for its institutional investors."
